Skovby Friskole's values are based on a philosophy of freedom with responsibility, where actions and consequences are closely connected.




#### Well-being and high self-esteem

#### **Mutual respect**


This is achieved through tolerance, appreciation of individual uniqueness and backgrounds, and taking oneself and others seriously.

### STATEMENTS FROM PARENTS:

## WHY MY CHILD ATTENDS SKOVBY FRISKOLE? LET ME TELL YOU!

Students are taught at their personal level.

Affirmation is a natural part of every school day.

Students learn they are valuable individuals.

Teachers are deeply engaged in their work and students' well-being.

Students respect each other and their teachers.

#### **School hours**

At 8.00-13.30 Monday-Thursday and Friday at 8.00- 12.30. We ask that students arrive before 8:00

We ask that students arrive before 8:00 a.m. If a student arrives later one day, we ask that they say goodbye in the hallway and the child enters the class alone. This disrupts the class as little as possible.

In preschool it is possible to meet 7.00-16.30 (15.30 on Fridays).

#### Information email

The school regularly sends out information about various initiatives via email.

The headmaster also sends out newsletters and invitations to events to your provided email address.

On the school's website www.skovbyfriskole.dk you can also find information about timetables, holiday plans, etc. The school's everyday life can also be followed to some extent on the school's Facebook and Instagram (@skovbyfriskole)



#### **School milk option**

It is possible to order school milk for your child. This is ordered and paid directly at www.skolemælk.dk, and it is delivered to the school on all school days.

#### Pencil case

The pencil case should contain:
Colored pencils, a good pencil
sharpener, a quality eraser, and five
sharpened pencils.

#### **Notification of illness**

Call or text the class teacher between 7.00-8.00

#### **Breaks**

There are two breaks during the school day.

1st recess at 9.40 -10.05 and 2nd recess at 11.40 -12.05. Meal breaks are included in both breaks.

There is an outside guard and an inside guard in the breaks, so students can always find an adult.

Smaller breaks are held between recess periods as needed in the youngest classes.

#### **Personal computer**

From 4th - 9th grade we ask that students bring their own computer for teaching use, as we use online teaching ressources supplemented with the textbooks in teaching.

We recommend a Chromebook, which is available from approx. DKK 1500 It is an excellent school computer.



### Camp at the school

The school year starts with a week of camp at the school where students in 3rd-9th grade stay overnight at the school. During the week, pleasant and challenging competitions, physical activities, team building, reflection and visions for the coming school year are shared and developed together. The pupils in grade 0.-2nd participates in daytime hours at 7.00-16.30 with their own separate programme.

#### Birthdays in Grade 0.-3rd

If you wish for your child to celebrate their birthday in class at school, you can send the invitations with your child—preferably four days in advance. Additionally, please ensure that whatever you want your child to serve to their classmates is delivered to the school on the day, and we will arrange for a pleasant celebration. You are, of course, also welcome to invite the class to your home for the birthday party. If you choose to host the party at home, we kindly ask that you invite either the entire class, all the boys, or all the girls. Students in grades 4-9 are welcome to bring and share cake or similar treats during the school day.

#### **Events**

During the school year, two festive events are held, where the students have prepared performances, exhibitions, workshops etc., and all parents are invited for a few pleasant hours together. Usually a summer party is held at the end of the school year and a Christmas party is held in December.

At the general meeting, information is given on the year that has passed, new initiatives, finances, and elections are made to the board of the school.

#### **Contact the school**

You are always welcome to contact the teachers at the school at +45 29843225 with any current questions, or in urgent cases, privately between 07:00-08:00 and 14:00-17:00. The teachers will, of course, also contact you if there are any uncertainties. Additionally, meetings between parents and teachers are held twice a year, where the class teachers discuss each child individually with their parents.



#### Snow

When snow falls, and in the event of a snowstorm making roads impassable, it may be necessary to close the school. If this is required, an email will be sent, and the information will be posted on the school's website by 6:30 a.m. on the same day. Additionally, it will be announced on Facebook and mentioned on Radio Sydhavsøerne.

#### **Play dates**

Parents will receive a contact list, and we kindly request that playdates are arranged directly between parents so that the child does not need to make calls about this during school hours.

## After School Program (SFO) Hours

On school days from 7:00-8:00 and Monday to Thursday from 14:00-16:30, Friday from 13:00-15:30, as well as two weeks during the school summer holidays. Note: In the case of a seven-week summer holiday, the after-school care (SFO) will be open for three weeks.

## The school schedule from April to the summer holiday for pre-school

This period is seen as a "learn to go to school period" with many playtime sessions, creative activities, physical education, and few academic lessons, allowing the students to adjust to the learning environment. Academic teaching will focus on Danish and mathematics.

#### **Change of clothes**

In the children's wardrobe, there is space for: two pairs of mittens, a hat, a snowsuit (which can be replaced with a rain suit depending on the season), a jacket, a pair of shoes, and a pair of indoor slippers. Additionally, the children have a box in the classroom where they are asked to keep a change of clothes. We kindly ask parents to maintain order in the children's boxes and wardrobe and ensure that they have the necessary items.

## Your child's class and teaching

From april until the summer holiday, your child will attend pre-school. Pre-school is a special time to get to know the school, the students, and the staff, explore the school grounds, develop new skills for attending school, and play with peers. Starting in August, your child will move on to Grade O.

At Skovby Friskole, students receive individually structured teaching, meaning your child will always be challenged at an academic level appropriate for their unique abilities.
